380 students, 30 minutes, priceless lesson

Group lesson made possible by generous donors

It took only 30 minutes, but on Wednesday, March 24, more than 380 students were trained in CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) in the Pilot Room of Discovery World in Milwaukee. The students attend the 7th grade in nine different MPS schools. The event was a joint effort of the American Heart Association, Discovery World and MPS, and was funded by the A.O. Smith Foundation, the MPS Foundation, the Evan and Marion Helfaer Foundation and the Albert J. and Flora H. Ellinger Foundation. The students each went home with a CPR kit that featured an inflatable manikin and instructions on how to perform the life-saving procedure.
